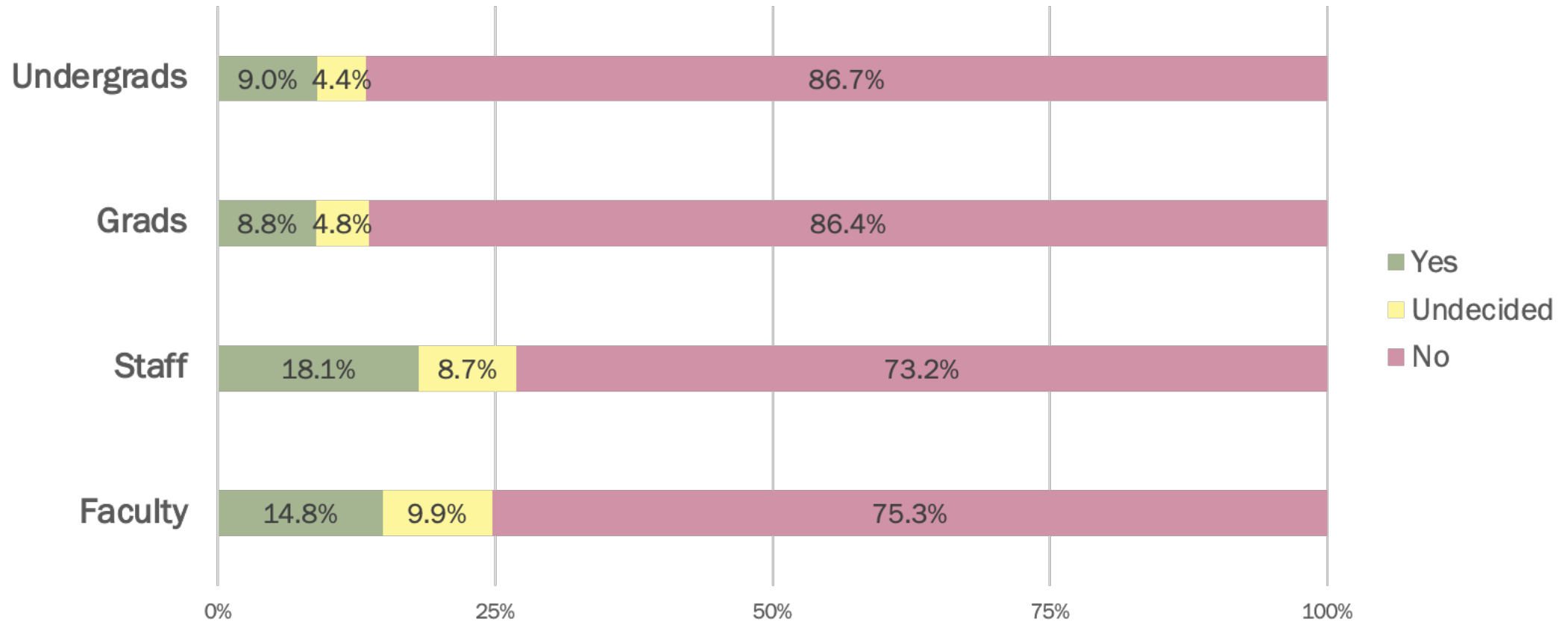

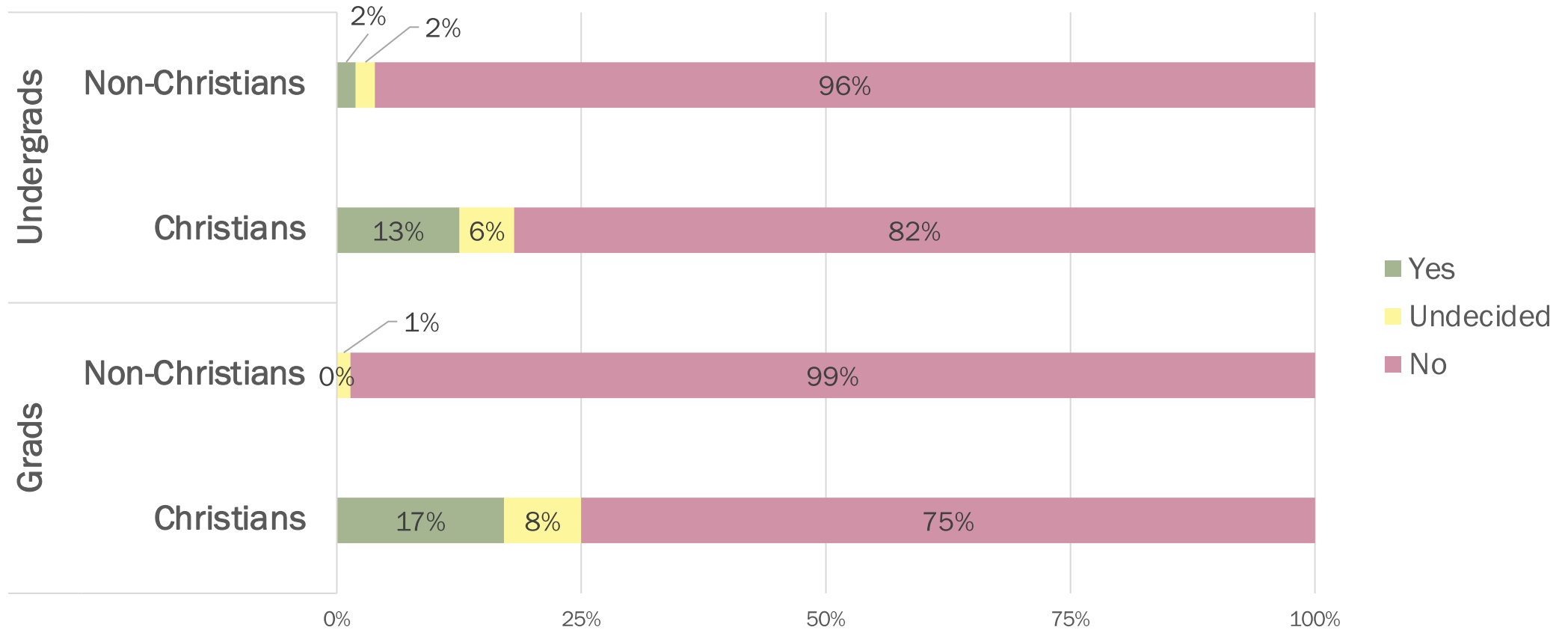

Of all student respondents, 63% identified as Christian.

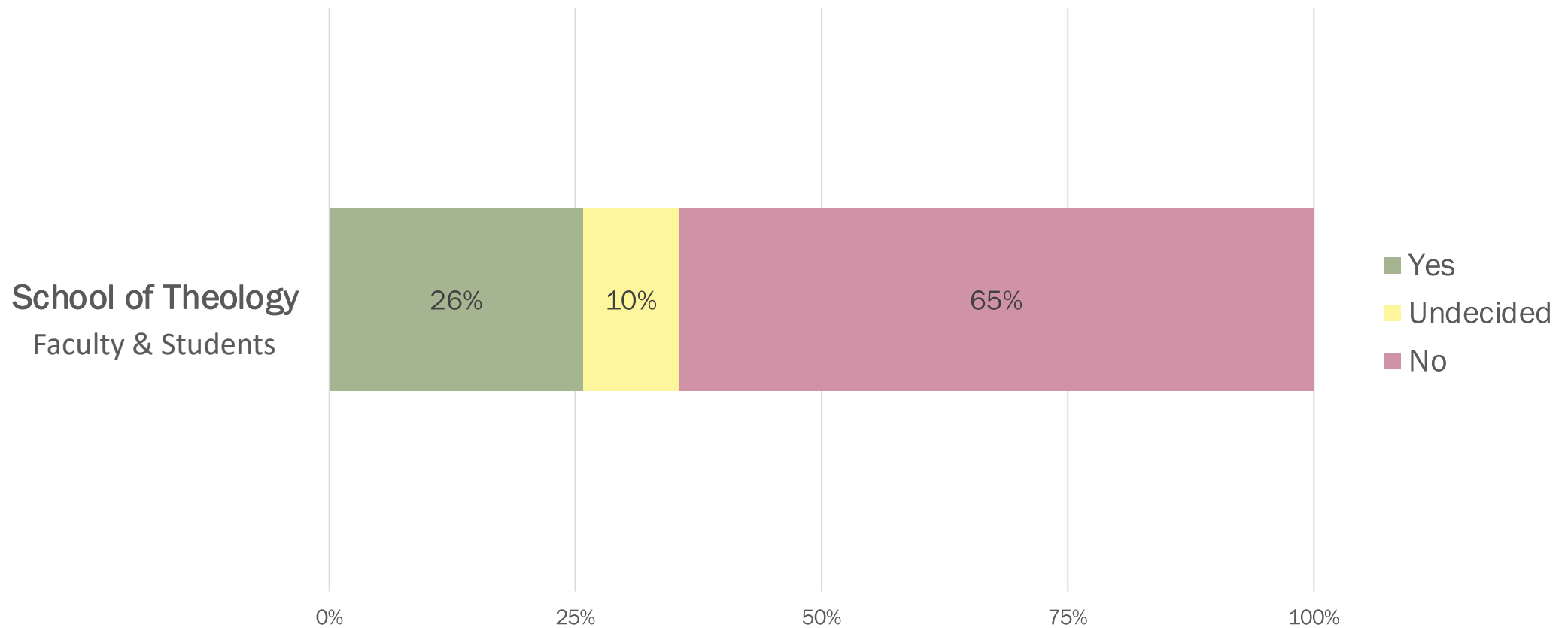

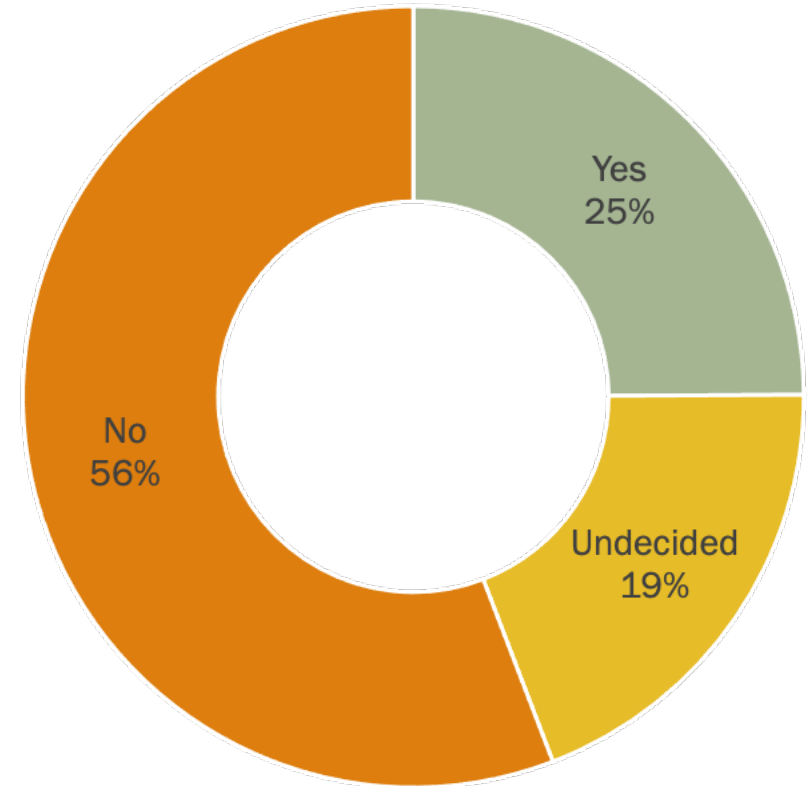

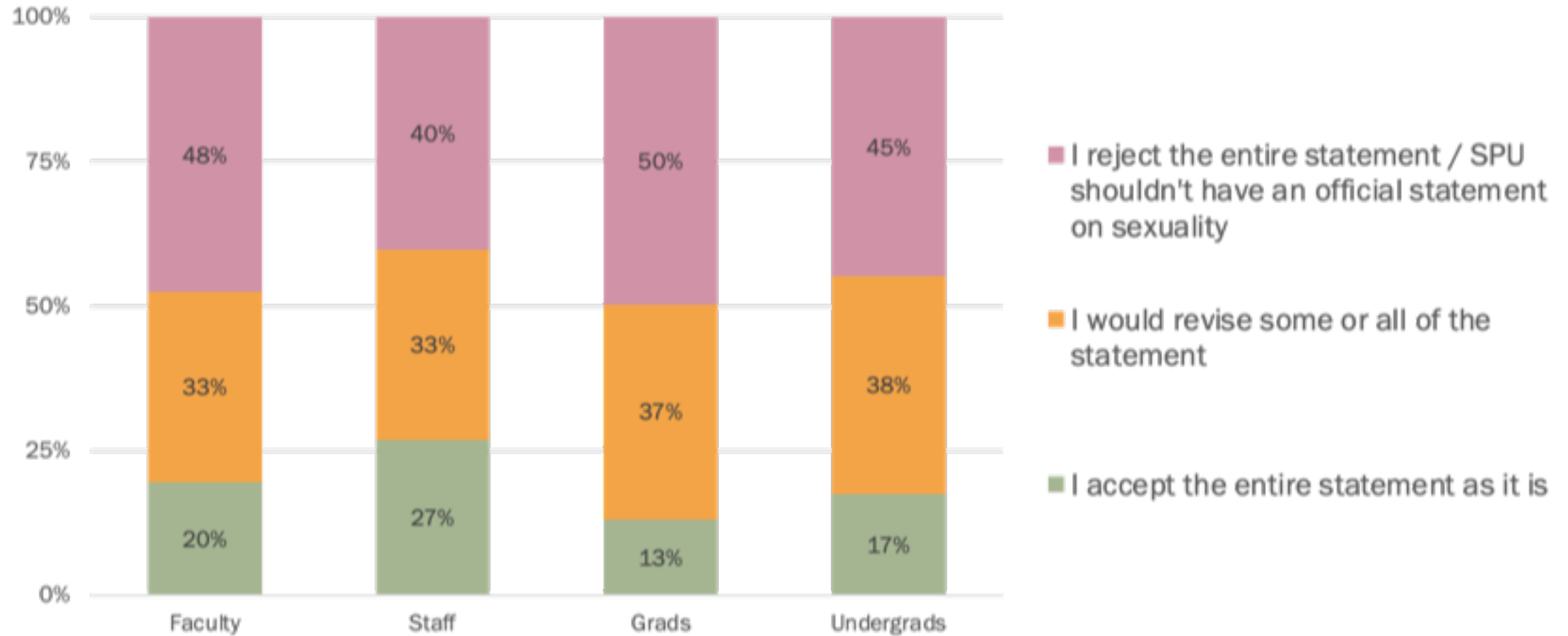

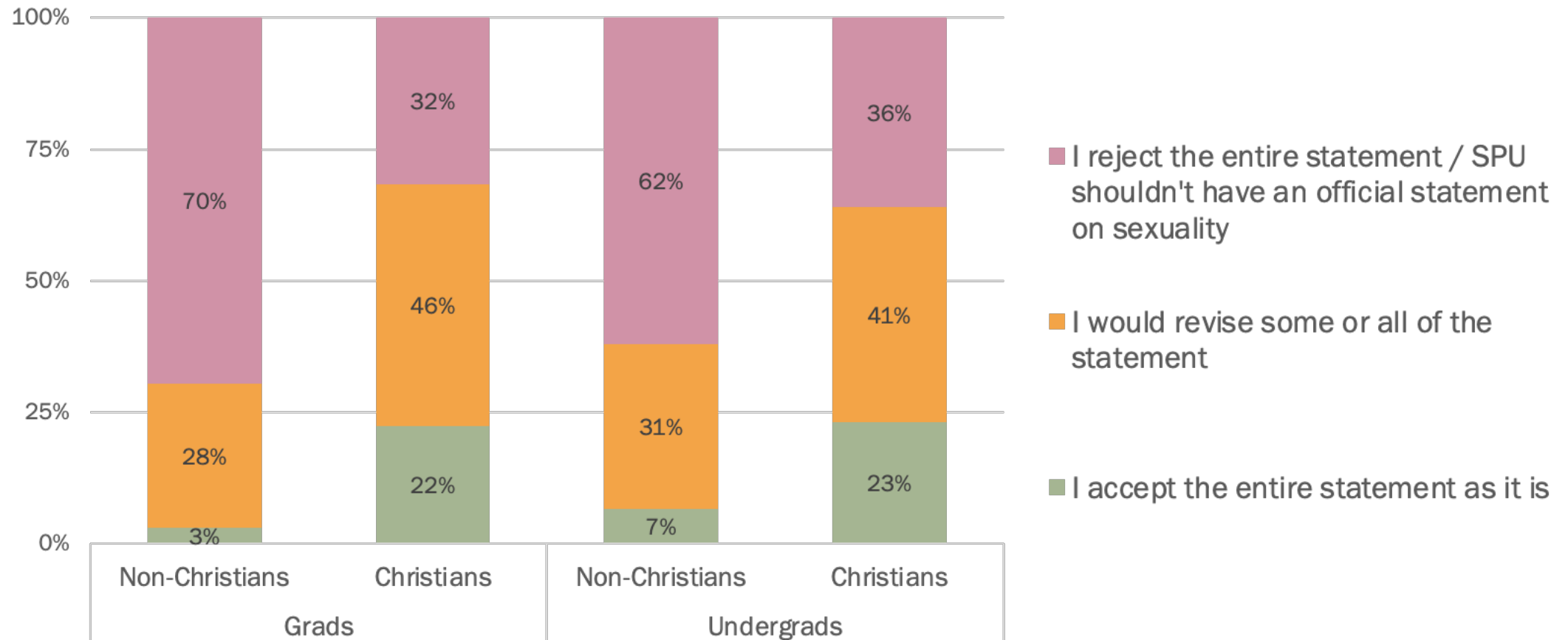


“Does the Statement on Human Sexuality align with your personal views regarding human sexuality?”

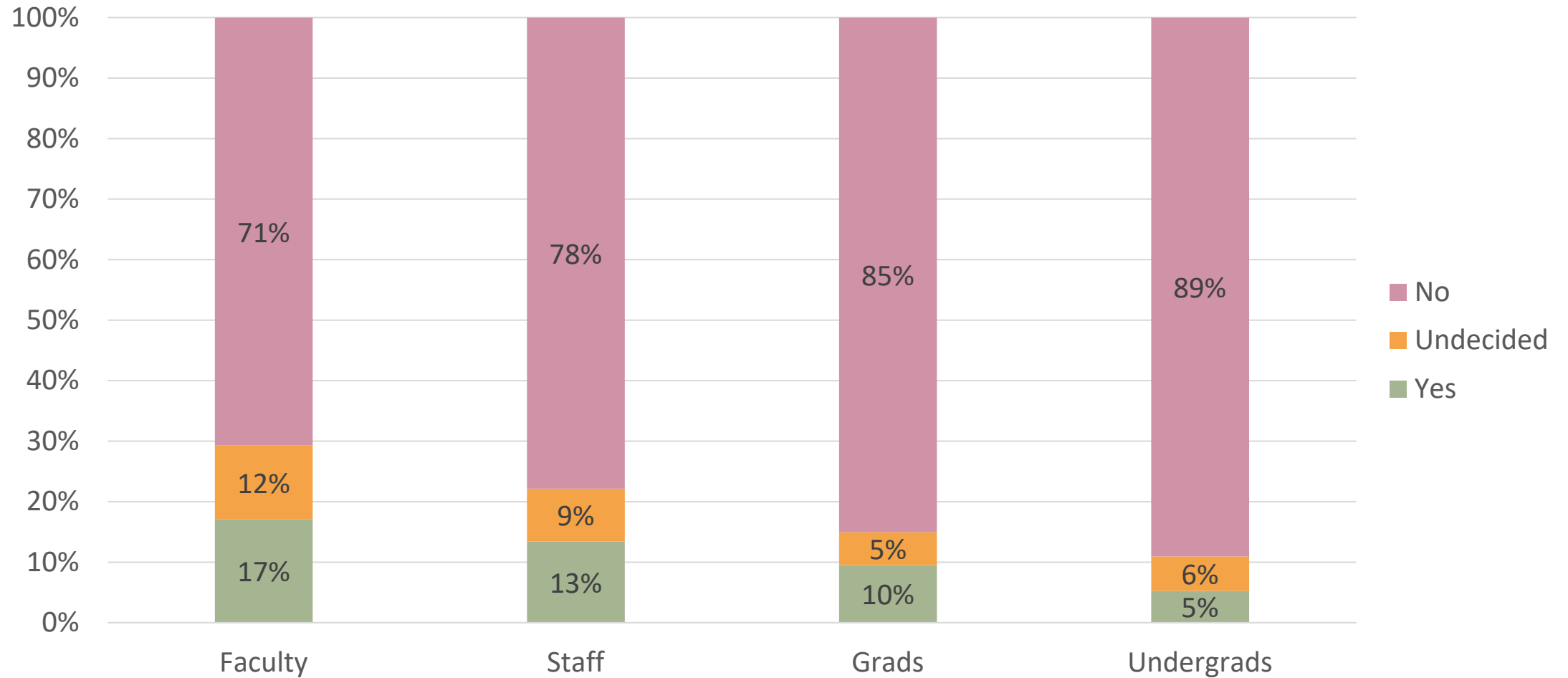
“Which of the following best describes your feelings toward the Statement on Human Sexuality?”



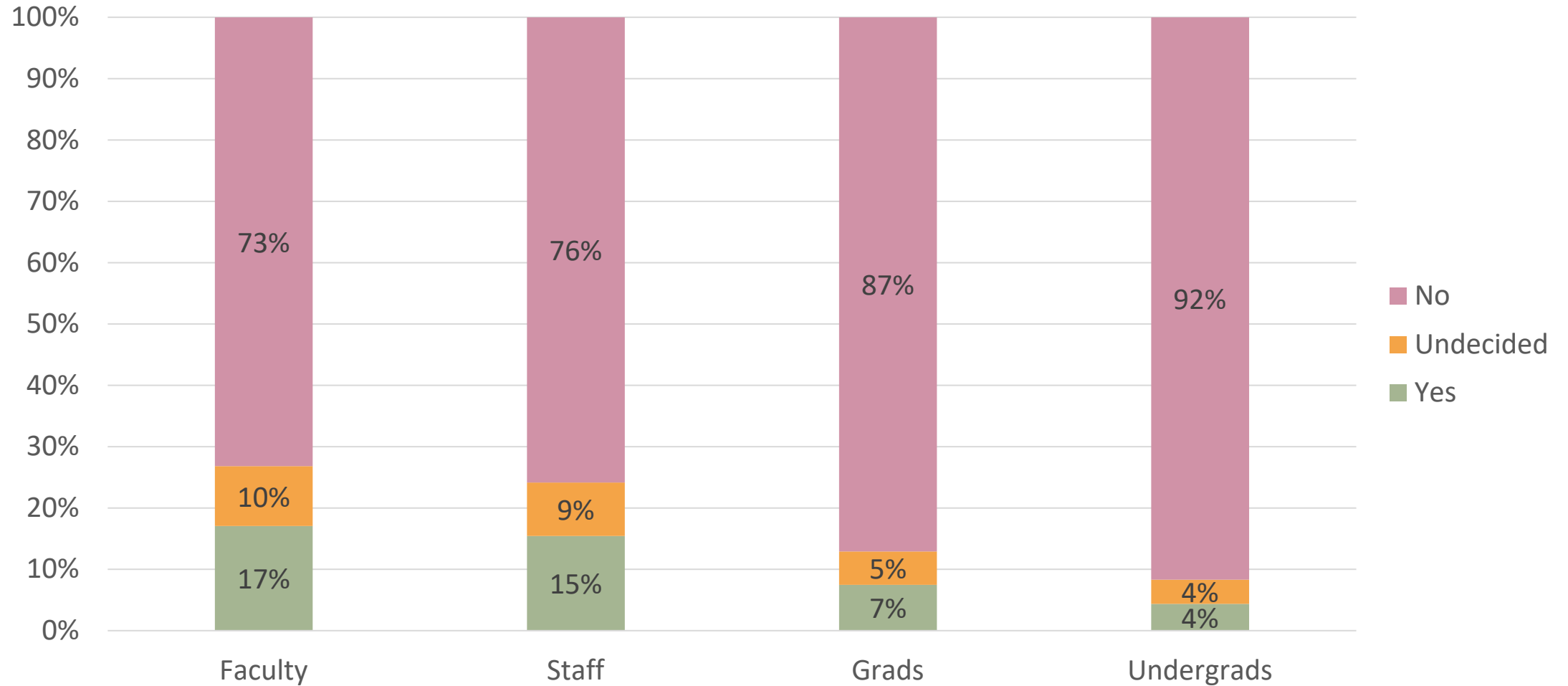
“Which of the following best describes your feelings toward the Statement on Human Sexuality?”



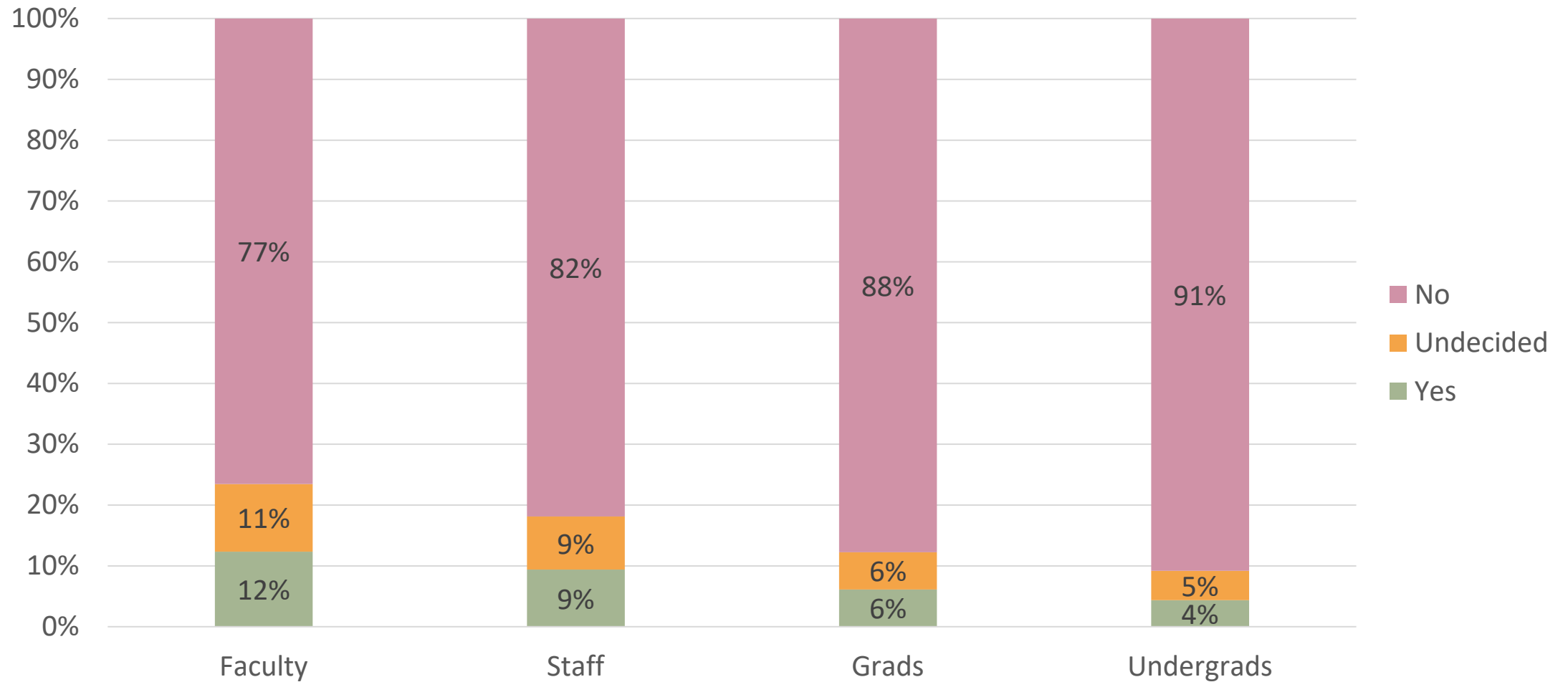
Should SPU have the ability to terminate faculty/staff or deny employment for premarital sexual activity?



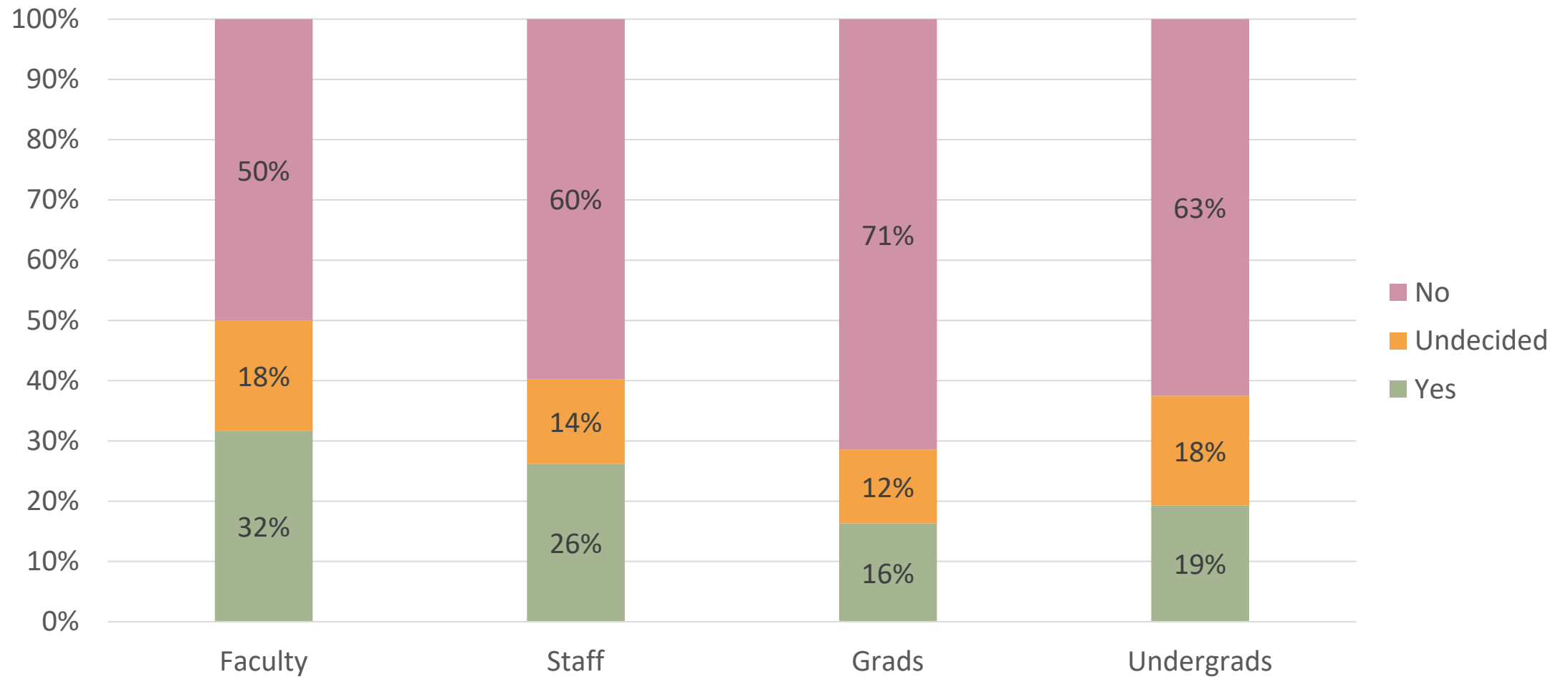
Should SPU have the ability to terminate faculty/staff or deny employment for living off-campus with a romantic partner before marriage?



Should SPU have the ability to terminate faculty/staff or deny employment for getting pregnant before marriage?

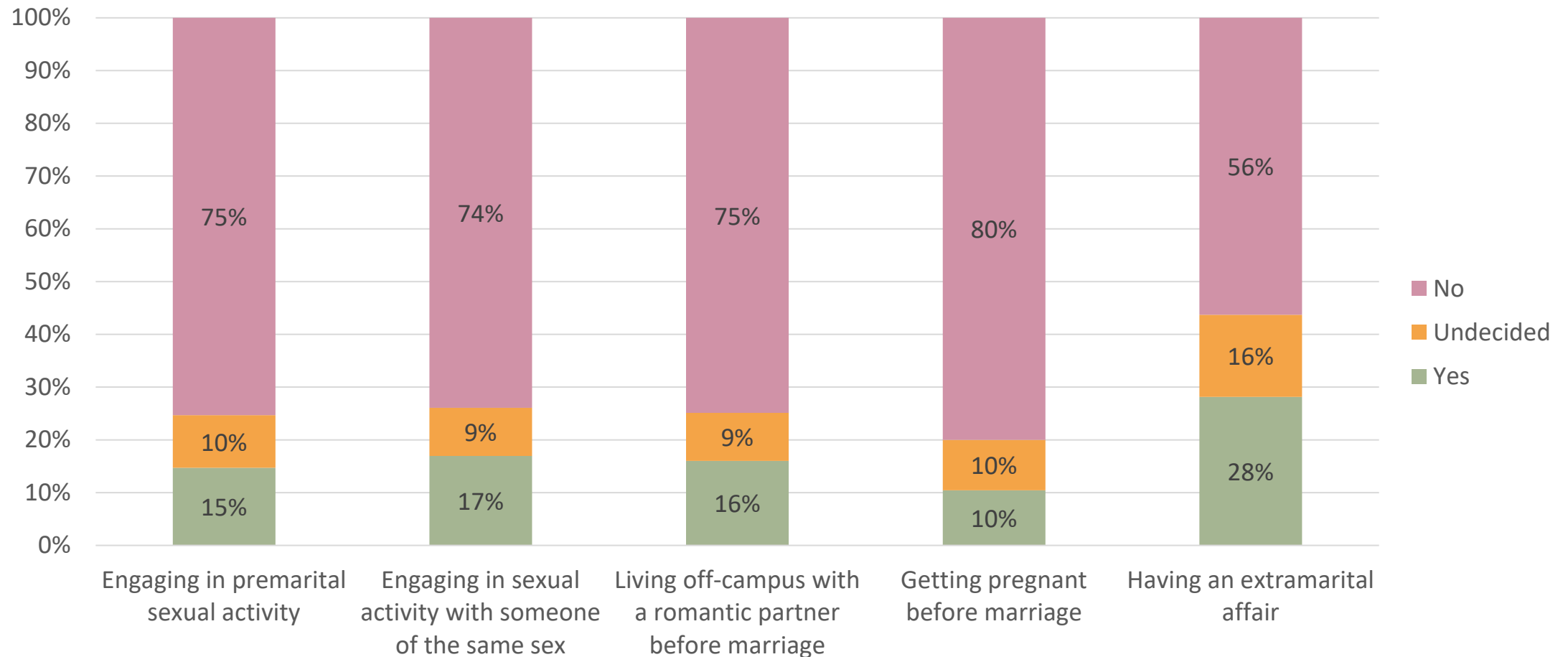


Should SPU have the ability to terminate faculty/staff or deny employment for having an extramarital affair?
